**Amendment No. 1 to
Interlocal Cooperative Agreement**

The Interlocal Cooperative Agreement between Puget Sound Educational Service District ("PSESD"), a political subdivision of Washington State and Bethel School District, a Washington State school district ("District") is hereby amended as follows:

Section 6. Membership Fee

At the March 14, 2018 Safety Cooperative networking meeting, the PSESD shared budget revenue, expenditures and projections for the past two years. Revenue for prior years have not covered expenditures. Each year salaries and benefits have increased approximately 4-6% each year due to COLA, increase in benefit costs and performance increases. In 2016-17 and 2017-18 the PSESD supplemented the Safety Cooperative budget with start-up funding to keep costs to districts stable. These funds will be depleted at the end of 2017-18 and it is necessary to find ways to increase revenue and decrease expenditures. Cooperative members in attendance at the March meeting agreed with the following ways to accomplish this effective 2018-19:

- 1) No longer serve lunches at all day meetings
- 2) Seek sponsorships to offset costs of speakers, conference room rental and food
- 3) Ongoing recruitment of districts and private schools who are not members
- 4) Raising of current rates for professional development training
- 5) Raise Safety Cooperative Member rates
- 6) Seek grants to offset costs to Cooperative members

Effective August 1, 2018, the annual Safety Cooperative membership fee shall increase to:

Attachment A Description of Services for 2018-19 PSESD Safety Co-op*

- Safety Leads Networking Meetings
 - Safety leads from across the region will have the opportunity to convene for the purpose of sharing best and promising practices, peer consultation and resource sharing.
 - Quarterly
 - Meetings will be 2 hours in length
 - Membership includes unlimited attendees

- Safety Specific Professional Development (PD)
 - Topics include: Investigative Interviewing, Suicide Prevention and Creating School Plans, and Reunification Plans
 - Quarterly
 - PD will be 3-4 hours in length
 - Membership includes two attendees*

- Safety Institute (August 1, 2018 & January 10, 2019)
 - A Summer and Winter one-day Safety Summit covering a variety of safety related topics as developed by safety leads across the region. Tracks may include: HIB, Right Response, Threat Assessment, De-escalation, Crisis Response Team, Active shooter, Continuing Operations Plans, Culturally Relevant Safety Practices.
 - Twice a year
 - Membership includes four attendees*

- Strengthening School Resource and Security Officer Services
 - This training will focus on clarifying common misconceptions among the roles and responsibilities of SRO, SSO and administrators in this process and provide a booster in trauma informed de-escalation skills.
 - Annually
 - Membership includes four attendees*; Teams of administrators and SSO's preferred

- Incident Command System: Training & TOT
 - Participants will be trained in ICS in the morning and will be trained to deliver ICS content to their staff in the afternoon.
 - Annually
 - Membership includes two attendees

- Active Shooter Roundtable
 - Participants will learn about the different responses to active shooter and will gain strategies to coordinate active shooter prevention and response with local law enforcement, community agencies and the school community.
 - Annually
 - Membership includes two attendees*

- Resource Subscription
 - Membership includes a subscription to monthly website repository for research, media templates (in multiple languages), sample policies, forms & upcoming cross-system trainings.
