Uniform Change Notice

Starting the 2022-2023 school year, the Cedarcrest uniform policy will no longer allow hooded garments. This will include current Cedarcrest hoodies and hooded jackets, as well as, layered clothing that has a hood.

Note: Once the current stock of hooded garments is sold out, we will no longer sell hooded garments.

All students must enter Cedarcrest Middle School in Cedarcrest uniform and remain in dress code throughout the school day. All students must wear clothing that fits. We will not sell clothing that is too small or too large. Additionally, clothing must be unaltered and in good repair (no holes, writing and/or colored ink). All clothing needs to be appropriate for school. Markings or insignias on clothing or the body must not be obscene, suggestive, or advocate disruption, sexual, or illegal activity. Clothing may not advertise or promote alcohol, tobacco, drugs, gang affiliation or activity or weapons. Student safety is our main concern.

Uniforms can be purchased in our ASB Office or from Always Great Graphix at alwaysgreatgraphix.com. Uniforms purchased at other locations may not meet the CMS Uniform expectations.

Pants	Solid Black Solid Tan Solid Blue	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Belts are not required, however, pants must be worn at the waist Waistband must fit securely at the waist, above the hipbone, with no shorts/underwear/boxers showing NO SAGGING! Zip ties will be used if pants are sagging below the waist Shorts must be no more than 2 inches above the knee Black, tan or blue jeans are acceptable; Must be solid colors; No grey, maroon, etc. Jogger style pants are allowed as long as they are khaki material Must be in good repair – no rips, holes, tears, frays of any kind No stripes, fading, acid wash or other color variations; Must be a solid color; No Athletics shorts, sweatpants, leggings/yoga pants, cargo pants, painter pants, zippers or chains No skirts or dresses

Accessories

Shoes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Footwear must be designed for public use at all times and have hard soles Heels must be 2.5 inches or lower All shoes must have heel straps or backs and be worn with the heel strap or backs No flip flops, sport sandals, sliders or slippers
Bandanas	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No bandana of any color Note: Bandanas are considered gang paraphernalia; school discipline will apply.
Jewelry, Hats, Headgear, Sunglasses	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Belts must be worn through the belt loops and not hang down No spikes, dog collar chains, pocket chains, bandanas, doo rags, rattail combs, picks, gloves, leather collars, tattoos, wristbands, etc. allowed Not to be worn in the building or during the school day on any part of the body Sweatbands, head scarfs, etc. are not allowed unless approved by administration prior to wearing it.
Coats, Jackets, Backpacks, Purses, Fanny Packs, etc.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Jackets/coats and backpacks/purses cannot be brought into classrooms; must be placed in the student's locker prior to the start of their first class Sling bags can be worn to transport clothes to and from PE only
