- All PCSC programs are year-round
- Students planning on PCSC must plan on a ½ day at SLHS and a ½ day at PCSC (1-2@SLHS and 3-5@PCSC **-OR-** 1-3@PCSC and 4-5@SLHS)
- Due to being a half-day schedule, students must plan on core classes at SLHS: English, math, science, and/or social studies classes only unless other arrangements are made directly with their counselor

Running Start Considerations

- Students may enroll in Running Start during (only) Junior and/or Senior year
- Students should attempt to complete all Physical Education, Art, and World Language requirements before attending Running Start
- Any student considering Running Start should make an appointment with their counselor to create a custom graduation plan
 - Students interested should still create a 4-year plan for SLHS prior to meeting with their counselor

Frequently Asked Questions

- Q: If a student has already completed the requirement (i.e. 4 fine art classes) where do additional classes in that category go?
 - A: They become electives.
- Q: What if I make a mistake filling out my Credit Status Card? How can I check to see if it's accurate?
 - A: The counselors fill out a copy of the Credit Status Card for Student Led Conferences. You will receive a personal copy from your counselor at that time. Please update/change your or speak with your counselor if your copy does not match the copy provided by your counselor.
