Welcome and Purpose

- Dr. David Hammond, Assistant Superintendent of Elementary Schools, welcomed all committee members and gave a brief overview of the agenda.
- Dr. Hammond reviewed the purpose of the meeting: *To identify schools in need of boundary adjustments to alleviate overcrowding and adjust catchment areas to utilize the few remaining locations for portable classrooms.*
