# Pre-School

Per RCW - 43.215.455

By the 2020- 21 School Year - Any child eligible for Early Learning programs shall be entitled to enroll in a program.

The December 2017 study of need showed Bethel as a priority 1 school district with 607 estimated underserved preschool age 3 and 4 year olds currently in the community. Bethel was only serving 30% of it's low income preschool children in ECEAP and Head Start programs.

To respond to this decision we applied for and were able to add 72 expansion slots to lower the number of underserved children in our community that qualify for services.
